There are no entry fees. All entries will be auctioned off with the proceeds going to fund the research projects and experiments of Stonehill College's Student Scientists.

- Download the entry form on IGEES.org fill it out and save a copy. Email to bostonbreeder@bostonguppyclub.com
- A printed copy needs to accompany the entries.
- Shipped in entries should arrive on or before Friday November 1st.
- Carry in entries must arrive before noon on Saturday.
- Fish will be displayed in GENE show containers.
- This is a pairs show. Each entry will consist of a Male and Female of the same strain.
- Fish will be judged and scored both as individually and as a pair.
- If a fish in the pair is DOA or missing the fish will be judged as a single only and will be penalized 100 points.
- Fish will be judged by the IGEES Open Show Standard.
